


# Break Even Crossword

Complete the crossword below using the clues provided.



## Across

- 1 The \_\_\_\_\_ of safety is calculated by subtracting the break-even level of output from the actual output (6)
- 6 The break-even point can be calculated using the formula: Fixed Costs/(Selling \_\_\_\_\_ - Variable costs) (5)
- 7 The break-even \_\_\_\_\_ occurs where total revenue and total costs are equal (5)
- 8 A break-even \_\_\_\_\_ illustrates the break-even point graphically (5)
- 9 The amount of profit being made by a business that is breaking-even (4)
- 10 This is made if a business is unable to make and sell enough to reach the break-even level (4)

- 11 This is made if a business is able to make and sell more than the break-even level (6)

## Down

- 2 Total \_\_\_\_\_ is the money received from selling the goods that are produced (7)
- 3 These costs will not change in direct proportion to the amount produced (5)
- 4 The goods that are produced (6)
- 5 \_\_\_\_\_ costs will be zero when nothing is produced and increase as more is produced (8)
- 8 Total \_\_\_\_\_ will increase as more is produced, but will not be zero if nothing is produced (5)
