


Break Even Crossword (Solution)

Across

- The _____ of safety is calculated by subtracting the break-even level of output from the actual output (6)
- The break-even point can be calculated using the formula: Fixed Costs/(Selling _____ - Variable costs) (5)
- The break-even _____ occurs where total revenue and total costs are equal (5)
- A break-even _____ illustrates the break-even point graphically (5)
- The amount of profit being made by a business that is breaking-even (4)
- This is made if a business is unable to make and sell enough to reach the break-even level (4)

- This is made if a business is able to make and sell more than the break-even level (6)

Down

- Total _____ is the money received from selling the goods that are produced (7)
- These costs will not change in direct proportion to the amount produced (5)
- The goods that are produced (6)
- _____ costs will be zero when nothing is produced and increase as more is produced (8)
- Total _____ will increase as more is produced, but will not be zero if nothing is produced (5)
